of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one thousand and eighty dollars to me in hand paid by Henry B. Prince of the District and State aforesaid do hereby grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry B. Prince a certain piece parcel or tract of Land lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of Duck Creek in the South Tyger River beginning on a Saw wood Camp at the head of his Spring branch thence down said branch to a white oak Camp thence to a Stake thence to a Stake an Asher Barrets line thence along Barrets line to Henry B. Prince's line to a Turkey Oak Camp thence along said line to a post Oak Camp thence to the Springing Corner it being part of a Tract of Land Granted to Ben Barrets and by him conveyed to Archibald Bell and by him to Ben Barrets Will and by him conveyed to John Bell and him conveyed to Cary M. Jackson and sold at his property by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville and purchased by William Barton before mentioned containing Eighty acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident to have and to hold the above mentioned premises unto the said Henry B. Prince his heirs and assigns and from me and my heirs and from no other person or persons who and whom and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to Quit Claim the above described premises unto the said Henry B. Prince his heirs and assigns and to hold no further and it is expressly understood and the intent and meaning is that I am to warrant and forever defend the above conveyed land from me and my heirs unto the said Henry B. Prince and his heirs and assigns and no further In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this twenty seventh day of December one thousand eight hundred thirty six signed sealed and acknowledged in the presence of us
