 District the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, I have given  
 bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents do give, bargain  
 well convey and deliver unto the said Samuel G Earle his heirs  
 assigns a negro girl named Mary supposed to be fourteen years  
 old, To have and to hold the said negro girl Mary unto the said  
 Samuel G Earle his heirs and assigns in trust for the sole use  
 behoof, benefit and advantage of my daughter Sarah C Yancey  
 and the heirs of her body forever, and it is hereby expressly under  
 stood that the said Sarah C Yancey is to have and enjoy the hire  
 labour and profits of the said Mary, and her future increase dur  
 ing her natural life & at her death her children are to have  
 hold and enjoy & receive the same to them and their heirs forever  
 And I do warrant and for ever defend the said negro girl Mary  
 unto the said Samuel G Earle, his heirs and assigns in trust for  
 the uses and purposes above mentioned Given under my hand  
 and seal November 17<sup>th</sup> 1836 — E R Earle Esq
