 and singular of the rest of my personal property to have and to hold all and singular  
 the aforesaid premises and property unto the said James Nash his Heirs Executors  
 Administrators and assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof forever  
 And I the said Thomas Nash do by these presents bind myself my Heirs Ex  
 cutors Administrators and assigns the said bargained premises & property unto the  
 said James Nash, his Heirs and assigns to warrant and for ever defend, Provided  
 notwithstanding and it is expressly agreed between the said parties that if the said  
 James Nash his Heirs Executors or Administrators shall well and truly pay or  
 cause to be paid unto the said James Nash his certain Attorney Executors Admini  
 strators or assigns the full and just sum of fifteen hundred Dollars with the  
 interest on the same before the 15th day of November next, then and in such case and in  
 all things from thence forth these presents and all the estate real and personal hereby  
 granted and every article, clause or sentence herein contained or understood shall  
 be void, determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes, any thing herein con  
 trary to the contrary notwithstanding. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
