 fifty six acres (more or less) situate in Greenville District on both sides of
 Maple Creek waters of Reedy River, commencing at rock corner at John
 Riddle's fence, thence N 40 W on lands of Jeremiah Adee and Lewis Rogers
 50 Ch 50 to Stone Corner 37 thence S 51 W 41 Ch 30 on lands of Lewis
 Rodgers to a post oak 3 X, thence South 40 E. 50 ch 40 on lands of William
 Ashmore and George Spillers to pine corner 37 thence N 31 Ch 70 (land
 of George Spillers and James Eggers to rock thence to the beginning
 corner together with all and singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging) or in anywise incident
 or appertaining) To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Lewis Rogers, his heirs and assigns for ever and we do
 hereby bind ourselves our heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and
 for ever to defend, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said Lewis Rogers his heirs and assigns forever, from and against all
 our heirs Administrators and executors, and against every other person or persons
 lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof we
