 of two hundred and twenty five Dollars to me in hand well and
 truly paid to be made the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge all
 that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and four acres
 the same more or less situate in Greenville and state aforesaid on the
 north side of Conoce river, beginning on a post oak S 68 E 39.70
 Lead Oak S 20 W 49 Pine Dover to the River, thence up the meandy
 of the river to a cross fence formerly Carny's line, thence with a straight line
 near the fence to the beginning. Together with all and singular the
 rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto appertain
 ing to the said premises or in anywise incident unto the said Austin
 Taylor his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself
 my Executors and Administrators, and my heirs to warrant & defend
 all and singular said premises before mentioned unto the said
 Austin Taylor his heirs and assigns against my heirs and
 assigns my Executors Administrators and every other person or persons
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I hereunto set
 my hand & seal this 17th January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight
