 incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said James. A. Ashmore his Heirs and Assigns forever and I do
 hereby bind myself. my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James. A. Ashmore
 his Heirs and Assigns. against me and my Heirs or any other person or persons
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
