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State of South Carolina. This Indenture made the 22nd day of February 1839 before
 Greenville District. Between Thomas Long of the State and District aforesaid on
 the one part & James Jones of the said District on the other part Witnesseth that the
 said Thomas Long for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy Dollars & eighty nine
 cents to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
 bargained sold released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell and release and confirm unto the said James Jones and to his heirs and
 assigns forever all the plantation and tract of Land whereupon the said Thomas
 Long now lives situate on the North side of Stoney Creek Waters of Reedy River
 Containing Eighty Acres more or less to have and to hold the above bargained
 premises to the said James Jones his heirs and assigns forever. Provides always
 and these presents are upon this express Condition that if the said Thomas
 Long shall pay to the said James Jones the just and full sum of Seventy Doll-
 ars and 89⁹⁰ on or before the Twentyfifth day of Decr next with lawful Int. on
 the same then the foregoing obligation to be null and void otherwise to remain
 in full force and virtue. Signed sealed and delivered the day and date

 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph M.
 McCullough a certain tract or parcel of Land containing twenty nine & 89⁰⁰ Acres
 situated in the State and District aforesaid lying on the Waters of Mountain
 Creek Beginning on a Hickory 3^x and running N 13 W 38.25 to a stone 3^x
 bounded by Mr. M. Cullough's Land thence N 47 W 9.80 to a Hickory 3^x bounded
 by Nathaniel Gaines's Land N 13 E 33.50 to Red Oak 3^x bounded by John Medlock's
 land thence S 56 E 8.10 to the beginning bounded by the said M. Cullough's Land
