 of land situate and being in the District and State aforesaid Commencing on a pine
 thence across the Buncombe Road N 45 E 33 to a pine thence N 46 W 23 25 to a red
 oak thence across the Buncombe Road thence S 60 W 45 to a Red Oak thence S 30 E
 27 to a Black Gum thence up the meander of the branch to the beginning supposed to con-
 tain one hundred and six acres or the same more or less Together with all and sin-
 gular the Rights Member hereditament and appurtenance to the same belonging or
 or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the pre-
 mise, abovementioned unto the said Nelson Gilbreath his heirs and assigns forever and
 I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and perse-
 er defend all and singular the said premises to the said Nelson Gilbreath his he-
 ir and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person persons whom ever
 or lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and seal in the second day of January in the year of our Lord
 one thousand Eight hundred and thirty nine Signed Sealed and in the presence of
 Griffith Jones Robert Stewart George Souter

 liver the within Deed of conveyance to Nelson Gilbreath for the use and purposes
