along said road N 29 1/2 E 17.5 chs to a Red Oak Sapling 3x on said road thence  
on said road N 22 1/2 E 14.50 to a stake thence on said road N 5 W 6.70 chs  
to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights  
members, hereditaments, and appurtenance, to the said premises belonging or  
in anywise incident or appurtenant; To have and to hold all and  
singular the said premises unto the said Henry J Thompson his heirs and  
assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and  
administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the  
said premises unto the said Henry J Thompson his heirs and assigns  
against myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever law-  
fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witnesses  
my hand and seal this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord one  
Thousand Eight hundred and Thirty nine and sixty third year of the
