South Carolina Greenville District } Know all men by these presents that I William Blasingame of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five Dollars to me in hand paid by Simon Lister of the same State and District have given granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and release unto him the said Simon Lister a certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina on the South side of Middle Tyger River, and bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a chestnut stump thence running South 3 1/2 degrees West 12 chains 67 links to a stake x 3 thence North 80 West 23 chains 50 links to a stake x 3 thence N 26 E 35 chains 75 links to Tyger River thence down the River 2 chains 75 links to a stake x 3 thence South 28 W 17 chains to a stake thence S 70 E 24 chains to the beginning corner containing thirty seven acres be the same more or less It being part of a tract of land originally granted to the chael Miller To have and to hold the above granted premises Together with all and singular the rights and privileges thereunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining unto him the said Simon Lister his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators & assigns forever to warrant and defend the above granted premises unto him the said Simon Lister his heirs and assigns against my heirs and assigns and against any other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 12th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two
