twenty third day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand
Eight Hundred and thirty nine between John Watson Ordinary
of Greenville District of the one part and Isabel C Field of
said District of the other part witnesseth That whereas the
said Isabel C Field stands justly indebted to the said John Watson
Ordinary as aforesaid his successor in Office or assigns in the
sum of Eight Hundred and seventy four dollars and 75 cents
for which sum the said Watson holds the note of the said Isabel
C Field and Alexander Nicol Secuity bearing even date herewith
and due the seventh day of October A. D. 1840 a reference to which
note will more fully appear Now this Indenture witnesseth that
the said Isabel C Field for and in consideration of the said debt
or sum payable aforesaid to the said John Watson or his
successor in Office and for the better securing the payment
thereof to the said John Watson or his successors in Office according
to the tenor and effect of the note aforesaid and also in consideration
of the sum of one dollar to the said Isabel C Field by him the said
John Watson in hand paid at, and before the sealing and delivery of
of these presents, do grant, bargain, sell alien release confirm and
convey unto the said John Watson Ordinary aforesaid and to his
heirs and assigns and his successors in Office forever a tract, piece
or parcel of lands situated in the District of Greenville in the State
aforesaid on Flat Rock Creek of Coopers River containing three
Hundred and twenty acres more or less, and hath such bounds
marked as follows viz Beginning at a P. C. 34 thence S. 40° 77' 55" E.
to a Red oak 34 thence S. 50° 6' 58" Chaining to a Stake 34 thence N. 40° 6' 55" E.
