The State of South Carolina. This Indenture made the seventh ¹⁷⁶
day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
and thirty nine Between George F. Towns ^{Esq.} Commissioner of the Hon-
orable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House
in the said State, of the one part and Micajah Jordan of the other
part: Witnesseth Whereas Rosanna Stone the Widow & Mrs Stone and
Martin Stone and all the other children heirs of the late Micajah
Stone dec^d on or about the seventh day of June did exhibit their
Petition in the Court of Equity, at Greenville Court House in the
said State, praying that a Partition might be made of the real
Estate of the said Micajah Stone dec^d amongst his heirs at law
according to their respective rights. And the same being at issue
before the Honorable Court, came on to be heard at five terms
when the said Court, after full hearing thereof, and mature
deliberations in the premises, did order, adjudge and decree
that the said Land of the said Micajah Stone dec^d should
be sold at Public Auction, by the Commissioner of said
Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their
decretal order, as informed thereto in the Registry of the said
Court will appear: - And the said George F. Towns as
Commissioner of the said Court, after having duly advertised
the said Land for sale by Public outcry on the said seventh
day of October first above mentioned, did thus openly and pub-
licly, and according to the Customs of Auction, sell and dispose
of the said Real Estate below described, unto the said Mic-
ajah Jordan for the sum of Four hundred & fifty dollars
he being at that price the highest bidder for the same. Now
therefore this Indenture Witnesseth, That the said George
F. Towns as Commissioner of the said Court, under and
by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the
sum of Four hundred & fifty dollars paid him by the
said Micajah Jordan the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged, hath granted, bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said ⁹⁵ Micajah Jordan his heirs and assigns all that Tract
