 of Richland Creek containing four hundred and seventy acres
 more or less: Beginning at the Junction of Richland Creek with its
 North fork, running up said North fork to a White Oak, Thence S 30.
 N. 5. 75 to a chimney stump thence S 11. E 20. 40 to a side oak stump thence
 Co. N. 10. 30 to a stake in the field, thence N. 32. 71 21. to a stake, thence S 47.
 N. 16. 50 to a pile of rock, thence N 9. E 40 to a Post oak, thence N. 31. E
 to a stake, thence S 30. N. 45 chains to a stake, thence S 70. E 27. 50 to a
 stake, thence S 11. E 11 chains to a stake thence S 45. 79 chains to a
 small Post oak, thence S 23. E 9 chains to a stake, thence S 62. 77. 50
 to a stake, thence S. 43. E 9. 50 to a Poplar, thence N. 27. E 150 to 13.
 Oak near the ditch and thence with the foot of the Hill to the
