To all to whom these presents shall come, David Henning Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid, send Greeting: Whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville to wit the Eighteenth day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty five at the suit of Edmund Maddox to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of John R. Hammond to levy the sum of Twenty two Hundred and fifty dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said John R. Hammond, all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land, containing Three Hundred and Twenty acres more or less, situate and being in the District of Greenville on the water of the inland bank of Rudy River, lying on both sides of the main Road leading from Greenville to Laurens Court House being the same whereon John R. Hammond the Defendant now lives, the Land herein meant to be described was originally granted to John Johnson and conveyed to the said John R. Hammond by the said Abiba Green.
