Greenville district } District and State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum
of one hundred and forty dollars to me paid by Thomas Howel of the same
State and district. have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Howel his heirs and assigns
forever a certain tract of land containing one hundred acres to the same more or less
situate in said district on the waters of Enoree River it being part of a tract of land
originally granted to Uriah Conner and hath such bounds marked & as follows viz
beginning at a small maple 3x on a branch thence the dividing line between the
said Thomas and Aaron Howel S. 106 26 ch^t to a stake 3x on the back line then down
said line S. 89 E. 36 ch^t to a stone 3x then N. 61. 40 ch^t to a stone 3x thence N. 91 W. 36. 65 ch^t to a
Post 3x thence N. 19 E. 38. 50 ch^t to a fallen down Pine 3x thence N. 85 W. 18. 50 ch^t to a Pine knot
3x then S. 6 W. 29. 30 ch^t to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any
wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
aforesaid unto the Thomas Howel his heirs and assigns forever
