






Together with all and singular the rights and privileges belonging or incident to the same and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the same against me & mine and every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof from the said Henry or his heirs assigns Executors or administrators In Witness of which I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 21 day of July 1836.
