State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that  
Greenville District J. P. David Henning of the District and  
State aforesaid in consideration of Five Hundred dollars being  
one half of the purchase money given for a tract of land purchased  
from Geo. Lyons and handed to Geo. Bowen and David Henning  
for One thousand Dollars on the 24<sup>th</sup> February 1832 the said sum of  
Five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by the said Geo. Bowen  
of Laurens District and State aforesaid Do. release & transfer for my  
self my heirs Exec. Administrators and assigns all my Interest re-  
spective in said Land containing Three Hundred and forty three  
Acres more or less which is more particularly described in the said  
Deed executed to the said Geo. Bowen and David Henning by Geo. Lyons of  
the above date together with all and singular the rights members,  
hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any  
wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
the premises above mentioned unto the said Geo. Bowen -  
his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
Exec. Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
my Interest in one half of said Tract of land having  
never paid any part of the original purchase Money of One thous-  
-and Dollars to Geo. Lyons but declined to take any part of said land  
and the said Bowen I have reason to believe paid all the money  
and by virtue hereof do warrant and defend against myself  
my heirs and against every person lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this
