hand paid by Alexander Savage of State and District aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander Savage all that
plantation or tract of land containing Two hundred and ten acres
situate in State and District aforesaid originally granted to Holla-
way Power the fifth day of June One thousand seven hundred
and eighty six containing two hundred and fifty acres the
above being part of the same butting and bounding as follows
viz. Beginning on a Spanish Oak 3 x n.m. thence \$20 W 33 to a pine
3 x thence \$6.36 7.50 to a pine 3 x bounded by Abner Jones thence \$21.
24 chs. to a pine 3 x n.m. bounded by Vincento Pelt, thence N 60 W 30 to a
Red Oak 3 x o.m. thence N 40 W 36 chs to a post Oak 3 x o.m bounded by
David Morton thence N 57.63.50 to a Stake & thence E 67.50 to the Spanish
Oak the Beginning bounded by John Austin a part of said tract
the above to include Two hundred and Ten acres the same more
or less together with all and singular the Rights members heredita-
ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining to the same to have and
to hold the said premises forever and I the said Thos. Austin
do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators or assigns to warrant & forever defend the
same from the lawfull claim of any persons or persons claiming the same witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this Ninth day of August 1824 in the Forty ninth year of
American Independence sealed signed and delivered in presence
