 that runs across the originally tract thence with Williams Milcays line
 to a chestnut a conditional corner thence with Johnstons Bains conditional
 line to the head of a branch thence down said branch to Bushy Creek
 thence down said creek to John N. Stators conditional line thence with
 said line to the Beginning Locust to have and to hold the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of land with every appertaining thereto belonging
 or in anywise incident or appertaining to the said Walter Stator
 his heirs and assigns forever against ourselves our heirs Executors
