with said line S 25 E 20 chains to a Stake 3x by a Pine thence due East across
the Creek 24.50 chains to the Beginning Post 3x3x Together with all and
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
to said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have
and to hold all singular the said premises unto the said Albert
Cunningham his Heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind
myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for
ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Albert
