

 and district aforesaid. I have granted and bargained and sold by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William H. Johnson his heirs and
 assigns a certain tract of land containing twenty eight Acres lying and being in
 the District of Greenville on the waters of Darlin's Creek beginning at a black Gum
 running N 30 E. 40 to a Stake thence N 27 to a White Oak thence up the branch 2 1/2 to a Maple
 thence up an other Branch by the Spring to the Beginning which includes the same to
 be conveyed granted to Holloway Power and convey to William H. Johnson and conveyed from
 Marchbanks. Which tract of Land I do hereby warrant the Right and title to the
 said William H. Johnson from myself my heirs Executors administrators and all persons
 or persons claiming any right or title to the same or any part thereof to unto the said W.
 H. Johnson his person or person's assigns forever. Witness my hand and seal this 25th day
 of August in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine
