Barton Jr. the line Beginning between said Barton and Goodlett on a small red Oak N.W. from the Spring on S. Barton's line thence to the center of the said Spring thence down the meanders of Spring branch to still place where sufficient room is reserved to S. Barton for sitting thence down the meanders of said branch to the ford near the fence thence N. E. the Old bridge now to a wild cherry tree near the Grave Yard thence N. E. or perhaps a little S. E. to an Iron Wood corner on E. bank of a Ditch near a Shoul on the said S. Barton's Original line. The above is a conditional line laid out by Jesse and Prind. Goodlett in the presence of the said S. and Wilkin Barton. Thence up said ditch with Barton's line to a stone corner thence the ditch again and foot of Hill to an Ash corner on Joseph Barton's line thence with said line and Esq. S. Barton's line to a Red Oak corner thence to the Beginning together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Spartan Goodlett his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Spartan Goodlett his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns forever witness my hand and seal this 18th day of September AD 1832

Now the object of the above deed is this that Jesse & Elizabeth Goodlett my father and Mother shall have the liberty of living on said place and enjoy all the Benefits thereof during their life or pleasure and at their Deaths the said Spartan Goodlett is to sell the Land to the best possible advantage and divide the proceeds thereof equally among all my Brothers and sisters at the death of either my Father or Mother should it be the request of the surviving and the said S. Goodlett may sell or rent the said land during her or his life as may seem best
