in the consideration of seventy five dollars in hand paid by Moses Fowler of the State aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and relinquish the said J. Moses Fowler Two hundred and fifty acres of Land lying and being in Greenville District and State aforesaid Beginning on Bladders Beardsdam Creek on a Sugar Gum and running from thence along Wadsworths line to a Pine and from thence to a Chestnut and running from thence to a Red Oak and running from thence along Wm. Tute line to a Pine and thence along Robert Nelsons line to a Red Oak and thence along John Sparks line to Beardsdam Creek thence up the creek to the Beginning. The premises together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments Appurtenments to the s<sup>d</sup> premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises belonging unto the said Moses Fowler his heirs and assigns for ever & I do bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and ever defend full and singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises unto the said Moses Fowler his heirs against myself and against Every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand seal this 12th day of Sept 1839. the conditions of the above obligation is such that if Thos. Edwards do pay Moses Fowler the sum of seventy five dollars in current Money by the 25th day of December Next the above obligation is to be null and void and if Not to stand in full force
