The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above David Benjamin Harris shall make or cause to be made unto Aaron Stator his heirs or Assigns a good & lawful title to a certain tract or parcel of land containing One hundred and fifty acres more or less as described by a Deed given by John Stator to said Harris the 18th Dec^r 1807 situate on both sides of the Middle fork of Saluda River. Beginning on a White Oak Oil Camp Creek straight line to the Original line a Conditional line to the River made by John Stator Jun^r & John Stator Jun^r to a Black Gum on the River thence down the River to the mouth of Spring Branch to a Red Oak conditional corner. From thence to the Old original line thence along the said line to the Youngs line to a conditional line made by John Stator & the said Harris thence across to Oil Camp Creek to a Black Gum up said creek to the Beginning corner. if the said Benjamin Harris his heirs or Assigns shall make the said Aaron Stator his heirs or Assigns a good & lawful title to the above described land without fraud or further delay when the said Stator makes the last payment for the land then the above obligation to be void & of no effect otherwise to remain in full force and power in Law signed in presence of John Gowan

Beginning on a White Oak now cut down A Bush marked
near to the same place on the Bank of Camp Oyl Creek straight
line to the original Bradens line conditional lines to the
