Long of the district aforesaid in consideration of Fifty six dollars & 33/100 to him in hand paid hath bargained sold and released and by these presents doth bargain sell and release and in plain and open market deliver unto James Jones of the district aforesaid the following property (viz) Twenty barrels of corn Five hundred bundles fodder One Cow six Boards of Hoops Two beds & furniture One side board Two Chests One table Cuts & saucers Plates Knives Forks & cooking utensils to have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned property unto the said James Jones his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever - Provided nevertheless and it is expressly agreed between the said parties that if the said Isaac C. Long his Executors administrators &c shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said James Jones his certain Attorney Executors Administrators or assigns the full sum of Fifty six dollars & 33/100 on or before the 1st day of December 1840 then the above bill of sale and every article and thing therein contained shall cease and be utterly void or else remain in full force and virtue signed sealed & delivered this 24th day of November 1840
