before me this 7<sup>th</sup> day of Decr 1840

State of Georgia. Know all men by these presents that Peter  
Vandermon of Greenville Dist and State aforesaid in consideration  
of the sum of thirty two dollars & 3/4 cts to me paid by John S  
Mayfield of the of Ga and state aforesaid have granted bargained  
sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and release unto the said John S. Mayfield nine & one  
fourth acres of land laid out as follows beginning on a P. O 3/4  
on Pollards line thence N 87 W. 13 ch. to Stake on the Road 3/4  
thence N 24 W. to P. Oak 3/4 on the Road thence N 35 E 19 Chain  
to Ash 3/4 near Poplar in head of Spring branch N 30 W. 1.20 to N. Oak  
3/4 thence N 51 E 1.80 to B. Gum 3/4 thence up the branch to poplar  
in the head of branch thence S 24 E 5.75 to Oak 3/4 near the Meeting  
House thence S 31 W. 15.50 to Red Oak 3/4 the Beginning corner  
including nine and 1/4 acres together with all and singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said John S. Mayfield his heirs & assigns  
for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors  
and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all  
and singular the said premises unto the said John S  
Mayfield his heirs and assigns against myself and my  
heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and  
seal this 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1839 and in the 13<sup>th</sup> year  
of independance of the U. S. A
