

thence South 52 degrees West 417 feet to a Stake. thence North 38 West 208 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a Stake on a line of land sold to Sam'l Thompson thence North 52 degrees East (417) feet along a line of the said Thompson's land to a Stake near the Buncombe Road. thence S. 38 degrees East 208 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet with or nearly with the Buncombe Road to the Beginning, containing two acres of land more or less the same having been originally sold in two separate acres lots by me to James L. Pennings & who held my bonds for titles. & Pennings not having paid the original purchase money his equitable interest was leased on and sold by the Sheriff of said District when Mrs Emily Rowland became the purchaser & the Sheriff having the lands has given them to me & I have accordingly conveyed the lots to her. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Emily Rowland her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Emily Rowland her heirs and assigns against myself and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
