to a Water Oak on the bank of the Mountain Creek
on the South Side thence down the meanders of the Creek
to a Maple at the mouth of a branch on the North Side
of the Creek thence up the Branch to a Sweet gum
Which is N 32 E N 12 - thence N. 81. 88. 10. 7 ch to a Black
Oak, thence S 22. 4. 2. 86 ch to the beginning corner
