Lynch in the State aforesaid I have granted bargained. sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said W. E. Lynch all that tract of land lying and being in the district aforesaid on Waters of Enore on both sides of main Road leading from Greenville Court House to Ashville North Carolina adjoining lands as follows-

Beginning on Marenicks Hickory Corner and running westerly with Marenicks line to the Old Road. Thence along the said Old Road a South Course to the Grassy Branch at the Pole Bridge. thence easterly down said branch to Lynch's Corner on a black Gum. thence North Course to the beginning Hickory Corner on Marenicks line. Containing sixty acres being the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have or to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W. E. Lynch his heirs and assigns forever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said W. E. Lynch his heirs and assigns against me my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty first day of January A. D. One thousand eight hundred and forty one and in the sixty sixth year of the Independence of America. signed and delivered in the presence of
