 paid by Ruelin Cox of the State & District aforesaid have granted and by
 these presents doth sell and release unto the said Ruelin Cox Twenty
 three Acres of land more or less lying in Greenville District on the North
 side of Rockey Creek. Beginning on a Hickory on Agilla Long's land
 thence S. W. to a Maple tree. S. to the Branch on a stone. Thence down
 said branch South to a White Oak. thence N. W. to a stone corner on
 said Ruelin Cox's line. thence N. W. on said said Cox's line to a stone corner
 thence N. E. to a post oak thence N. W. still on said Cox's line to the
 beginning corner containing Twenty three Acres more or less.

Together with all that appertains to said land and premises before men-
 tioned to the said Ruelin Cox his heirs and assigns forever. and I the
 said Isaac Richardson doth hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns
 to warrant and forever defend the above described land and premises
 to the said Ruelin Cox his heirs and assigns from all claimants
 that now is or may be made by any person or persons whatever
 claiming the same or any part thereof. In witness I have hereunto
