 Chestnut thence N. 10 E 57 Chs to a Chestnut N. 48 W on
 McClures line originally to a Chestnut Oak thence N. 4 E
 35 to a Poplar thence to the Beginning containing by estim-
 ation 170 Acres more or less being a part of a tract orig-
 inally granted to by Patent bearing date June 5th 1786
 unto Richard Brazile by references being to the several
 conveyances thereunto will make my title fully appear
 to have and to hold all and singular the premises
