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Know all men by these presents that I Peter Caulk of the  
District of Greenville and state aforesaid as well to provide a home and  
residence for Alexander McCaulley and Elizabeth his wife as in consi-  
deration of the sum of One dollar to me in hand paid the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged; have bargained, sold, leased and conveyed and  
by these presents do grant, bargain sell lease and convey unto the  
said Alexander and Elizabeth McCaulley all that, tract piece or parcel of  
land situate and lying in the District of Greenville Beginning on the  
head of a short branch and running 160 yards on McCaulley's line to a  
corner thence thence on the south 120 yards on Turpin's land to a  
corner thence on the west side 180 yards on my line and thence on  
the North side 120 yards on McCaulley's line to the beginning containing  
three acres more or less, and including the present residence of the  
said Alexander and Elizabeth McCaulley To have and To hold  
the above described piece of land with its appurtenances, rights and  
and members unto the said Elizabeth McCaulley for and during  
their lives and during the life of the survivor free from rents hindrance  
or molestation for and during their lives, and the life of the  
survivor of them and no longer and at the death of the said  
Alexander and Elizabeth and the survivor of them the land hereby  
and herein described to return to me and to become mine as  
fully to all intents, as if this deed had never been made and I hereby warrant  
and defend the said piece of land to the said Alexander and Elizabeth  
McCaulley for and during their lives and the life of the survivor  
of them against me and my heirs and every other person claiming
