The Barton Eyr & now stands as a corner between the said T. Barton & Jesse Goodlett thence from said corner westwardly to a white oak. thence thence now a corner of said Conditional line - thence S.W. till it intersects with the said Ninety six acre tract thence South 65 West five chains to a stake corner, thence S. 24 East till it intersects with the Ephraim tract now belonging to Wilson Barton. Thence the said Bartons line to the beginning - for the whole courses & distances see the several grants, - Together with all & singular, with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining - To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Thomas Barton his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors, & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said T. Barton his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 21 day of November A.D. 1831.
