 Greenville Dist in the State aforesaid. have granted, bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said Elijah Pike, All Our interest
 in the tract of land of which Davide Armstrong late of Green-
 ville Dist. didd seized & possessed. Containing Two hundred
 & forty acres be the same more or less. Originally granted
 to Andrew Thompson on 2nd day of February 1789.

Together with all and singular the Rights, members
 Hereditaments, and Appurtenances to the said
 Premises, belonging, or in anywise incident or appor-
 taining: To Have and to Hold, all and singular the
 Premises before mentioned, unto the said Elijah Pike,
 his Heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby
 bind Ourselves, our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators
 to warrant and forever defend, all and singular
 the said Premises, unto the said Eliph. Pike
 his Heirs and Assigns, against ourselves and our
 Heirs.
