 Greenville District presents that I Abra-
 ham Mayfield of the District & State aforesaid for and in
 consideration of the sum of seven hundred dollars to me
 in hand paid, have bargained granted and released & by these
 presents do grant bargain sell & release unto Mathias
 Rush of said District, the tract of land & plantation whereon
 he now lives it being part of the land which I purchased
 from Joel & Benjamin Graves, situate in said district lying on
 both sides of the Gap Creek Road on the waters of South
 Pyzer River & Beardam Creek - Beginning on a Stake near the Ruthe-
 -rford Road, thence S 83° 40' E. to a Stake, thence S 76° ten
 chains to a water C. corner of Cordletts land on the south
 bank of a Branch, thence up the meanders of the branch
 a small distance above the Head of said Branch to a Rock
 thence N 66° 30' 50 to a chestnut, thence N 7° 25 to a maple on
 the Branch thence up the Branch to a fork, thence up the
 left fork with Camp line to a conditional corner thence
 with said Camp line to a Pine corner near the Rutheford
 Road thence to the beginning containing about two hundred
 acres. Together with all and singular the rights members
 and appurtenances therunto belonging, to have and to
