 the same more or less, being part of a tract of land granted
 to Harris Mullin but successively for John Huger and conveyed to the
 said John Gordon (since deceased) by Waddy Thompson. Bounding and
 bounding as follows to wit Beginning on a Red Oak 3x and
 running thence N^o 80° to a P. Oak 3x thence E about 35° or 40° to the
 Roads, thence along Crawfords line (now of Richard Gantt) to the
 old original line, thence along the original line to the beginning
 which said tract of land was conveyed to the said Thomas
 John Gantt by J. H. Rosamond, by deed bearing date the 18th day
 of December 1833. Together with all and singular the rights
 Members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

 myself my heirs Executors and administrators and all
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
