 at the death of the said Belvanda then the said Trustee shall
 pay over the said One thousand dollars to Belvanda Holcombe's
 little daughter Mary Holcombe Pickett, to her own proper
 use, which the said One thousand Dollars as above men-
 tioned shall be in lieu of all dower or claim which the
 said Belvanda Holcombe then Pickett shall have against
 the estate of the said James Pickett, as witness whereof
 we the contracting parties doth set our hands and affix
 our seals this thirtieth day of November in the Year of
 our Lord A.D. 1841, and fifty sixth Year of the Independence
 of the United States of America
