Reynolds in the State aforesaid & District of Greenville in consid-
eration of the sum of Three Hundred dollars to me paid
by Roger Loveland in the State aforesaid, and District of Green-
ville have granted, bargained, sold and released, and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto
the said Roger Loveland. All that tract or parcel of land lying
and being in the District of Greenville on Beardam Creek
waters of South Tyger beginning at a Maple which is above
the Spring I use, thence running on Hills line E to a white
oak on Hills Spring Branch thence up said branch to the
corner between Hills and the said Reynolds thence E on
Hills line to a Stake thence N to a Red Oak thence N on Fishers
line to a Stake & thence on Browns line E to a white oak on
L. C. Reynolds Spring Branch thence to the beginning containing
One Hundred and thirty four acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditament
and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining. To Have and to hold all and
singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said
Roger Loveland his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do
hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said
premises unto the said Roger Loveland his Heirs and
assigns against myself and my Heirs and against every
Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
