Roger Loveland Deed of Sale for 269 Acres of Land 4

To Eli Hewins of South Carolina Know all men by these Granville District presents that I Roger Loveland of the district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and thirty eight dollars to me paid by Eli Hewins of the said State and District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release a certain tract of land unto the said Eli Hewins containing two hundred and sixty nine acres situated in the district and State aforesaid on the waters of Childers Bearadam Creek of South Tyger river adjoining lands of Elijah Will, Blake Baltow, and others a part of which tract was formerly owned by George Silvatho and conveyed by him to Jeremiah Cleaveland, and by said Cleaveland to Larkin Reynolds, and by said Reynolds to the said Roger Loveland. The other part being a tract of land formerly owned by Jacob Wilson and conveyed by him to James Brown and sold by the Sheriff of said District as said Brown's property and purchased by said Loveland. The whole of which is now to be conveyed has such bounds marks &c as follow: viz.

Beginning at a white oak 3x on the branch which runs through the tract thence down the meanders of said branch about 8 chains to the mouth of a small branch on the south side thence up the said small branch about 5 ch. to a Maple 3x near an Ash 3x near the head of said branch thence N 73 E 34.57 ch. to a white oak 3x on Elijah Will's Spring branch, thence up said branch 7.50 ch. to a white oak 3x thence N 76 E 8 ch. to a Stake 3x thence N 77 1/2 W 16 across the main branch 17.50 chs to a Red oak 3x thence N 77 1/2 W 21 chs to a Stake by a corner cut down Blake Baltow's corner thence N 43 W 37.50 ch. to a Stake in an old field near Mr Robinson's thence S 17 W on Wardsworth's survey 38 chs to a Pine knot 3x thence N 53 W 6.25 chs to a small Red oak 3x on Brockman's land (late A. J. Silvatho) thence S 53 W 23 chs to a Stake 3x thence S 27 E across the said main branch 36.50 chs to a Stake 3x (formerly A. Shickory 3x) thence N 36 E 8 chs to the beginning corner.
