saith Nathaniel Rector, a certain plantation or tract of  
land containing ninety acres. be the same more or  
less. Beginning on a white oak, thence N 38 chains to a Ches-  
nut thence S 70 E 15 chains 50 links to a Spanish oak, thence  
S. 57.5 chains to a white oak, stump thence S 15 E. 50 to a  
chestnut, thence S 9 E. 15 chains 50 links to a Red oak, thence  
S. 55. W. 16 chains to a chestnut oak, thence N. 23 W. 4 chains  
to a Hickory, thence S 67 W. 7.50 to a Hickory, thence S 70 W  
10 chains to the beginning corner the same being a part  
of a tract of land which I ~~the~~ have bargained to William  
Howards. Together with all and singular the rights mem-  
bers, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto
