The Elyah Nightower and Jane Nightower of the
 State of South Carolina and District of Greenville
 being of a Sound and disposing memory do make this
 our last Will and Testament, we do will and bequeath to our Alfred Can-
 trell a certain Tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the State of South
 Carolina and District of Greenville on both Sides of the North Fork of the Deep or
 Creek water of the North Fork of Saluda River is being four Survey and adjoining
 each other the first being part of a Survey granted to Ralph Smith the second being
 a part of a Survey or tract of land granted to Robt Prince the third being a part of
 a Survey or tract of land granted to Martin Adams the fourth being part of a Survey
 or tract of land granted to Andrew W. Walker and bounded as follows the first line beginning
 in a Black gum Corner or in near Ralph Smiths old line thence running on the said
 line N 70° W 34 Chs 75 links to a White Oak Corner thence S 20° W one hundred and
 fifty (fifty) Paces to a Stake Corner thence S 70° E 19 Chs 70 links to a large Blaze Poplar
 on the West Side of the Creek which is a Conditional line tree thence S 87° E 6 Chains
 70 links to a Blaze steeping dead gum tree on the East Side of the Creek which is a
 Conditional line tree thence S 69° E 8 Chs 89 links to a pine Conditional corner or
 near John Nightowers line thence S 35° E 3 Chs 75 links to the beginning corner containing
