Crook, all my interest in Fifteen (negroes) Kinny, Anarchy and her baby, and three other children, Washington, Lilla, & Malisa; Lucy and her two children, Weylis and Casharius Dallas, Caroline & Mary, Charles, John, and Maxwell, now in the possession of my Mother Mrs. Susannah Wynne; my interest being one fifth of said Negroes and their increase at my Mother's death. I now warrant and defend the said interest one fifth in all the above named Negroes and their increase to the said R. Loveland and A. B. Crook. This executor administrator or assignee forever. In witness whereof I will hereunto set my hand and seal the Twelfth day of October Eighteen hundred and forty one

Oak XIII on Thence N 41° E 9.10 chs to Spanish Oak XIII on Thence S 45° E 7.10 chs Red Oak XIII on Thence N 26° E 5.60 chs to the beginning Red Oak 3 x 6 which includes the land to be conveyed, together with all and singular the Rights Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the same, and to hold all and singular the premises
