and Fifty Dollars to us due us by Darius Green of the said State and District
have granted bargained sold and released and do by these presents grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Darius Green all our right titles and
interest that we now have or may ever have to the tract of Land wherein
Joseph Bradley now lives it being all the land conveyed to Rebecca Bradley
(our Mother) and to the heirs of her body by Henderson Miller by conveyance
dated 1st February 1834 and in this conveyance called Two tracts of land refer-
ence to said Deed will more fully appear. Together with all and singular the
right members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging
to have and to hold all and singular our right titles claims and interest in
the above land to the said Darius Green and his heirs and assigns forever and
we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend
the above named claims unto the said Darius his heirs and assigns against
ourselves our heirs executors and administrators and against all other persons claim-
ing the same, under us. In witness our hands and seals this 3 day of No-
