 District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and twenty five Dollars to me paid by Philip Bishop of same State and District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Philip Bishop a certain tract of Land containing Ninety and a half acres be the same more or less situate in the said District on the head waters of Enoree River it being part of a tract of Land originally granted to H. Moon and also part of the tract I now live on, and have sold to Lewis Bishop and such such bounds, marked &c. as follows (viz) Beginning at Rock S.X. marked M. thence N. 61. W. 7. 88 chains to a stake S.X. in and on old road thence down said road N. 51 1/2 E. 43 chains to a rock S.X. near Prew Bensons dec^d old residence thence N. 11. W. 6 to a rock near a persimmon tree thence N. 86. E. 7. 50 Ch^s to a stake by old orchard thence S. 22. E. 33 Ch^s to a stake on Maversicks line then along said line S. 82. W. about 40 Ch^s to the beginning Corner. Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Philip Bishop his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Philip Bishop his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against
