and forty one at the suit of William Orr to me directed
commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and
tenements of Charles Garrison to levy the sum of One hundred
and fifty five and ⁴⁵/₁₀₀ Dollars damages and costs I have
seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Charles
Garrison One hundred and ten acres situate and being in the
District of Greenville being lot No 3 of Benjamin Tarrant's
Deceased land adjoining lands of Willis Benson John Richard-
son et al beginning on a stake 34 near a branch thence N
47° W. 38.55. ch to a stake 37. the line between Lot No 2 and 3
thence N. 43° E. 28.65. to a stake 34 thence S 47° E. 38.55 ch to a
stake 34 thence S 43° W. 28.65. to the beginning And whereas the said
premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made
by virtue of the said writs of fieri facias before mentioned have been ex-
posed to sale at public vendue and purchased by Willis Benson
of the District and State aforesaid for the sum of Four hundred
Dollars being the highest sum that was bidden therefor, Now
know ye that I, William Mc Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid by virtue
of the said writs of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered
as aforesaid and by virtue of the statute in such case made and
provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of Four
hundred Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the
said Willis Benson the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby
acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these pre-
sents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Willis Benson
his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel
of land with its appurtenances, and all the estate right title and
interest which the said Charles Garrison of right had of in and to
the same, To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of
land with its appurtenances unto the said Willis Benson his heirs
and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said William
Mc Goodlett might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the
same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said writs of fieri
