these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Joseph  
McKinney, two hundred acres of land more or less being & lying in  
District & State aforesaid and being & lying on the waters of South  
River bounded as follows, Beginning on a Spanish Oak, running  
North to a red oak, East to Robertson's conditional line & on the con-  
-al line to Trammels & Hollop, and thence to the beginning corner, contain-  
two hundred acres more or less, together with all singulars the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Joseph M. McKinney his heirs forever  
And I do bind myself & my heirs to warrant and forever defend the  
above described premises from me & my heirs & all other persons whomsoever  
claiming any part or parcel thereof, Given under my hand & seal the  
6<sup>th</sup> day of December 1830.
