For a more minute description of the premises hereby conveyed, reference must be had to the said deed from the said R. Thurston to the said Sarah Davis containing five hundred acres, be the same more or less, together with all & singular the rights, members, Hereditaments, & appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident, or appertaining, To Have & To Hold, all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Choice Esq, his heirs and assigns, forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors, Administrators & assigns to warrant & defend, defend, all & singular the said premises unto the said William Choice Esq, his heirs & assigns against me & my heirs (assigns) against every other person or person whomsoever (lawfully) claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand & Seal this thirty first day of October, A.
