W. H. Ashmore, Thomas Mayfield of the State and District above
Said in consideration of one hundred dollars
to me in hand paid by William H. Ashmore of the State and District
aforesaid, have granted, bargained & released and by these presents do
grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said William H. Ashmore
Twenty acres of land more or less lying in the district aforesaid on the
waters of Ready River being part of a tract of Land originally granted
to John Pyle and signed by his excellency William Moultrie on the
1st of Septr 1786. the said twenty acres of land more or less is laid out
unto the said William H. Ashmore as follows, viz, Beginning on the
line near Wm Pollard (late) house, thence eastwardly to Wm H. Ashmore's
corner, on same line, thence along same line, to the branch thence up
the meanders of the branch to the beginning including twenty acres of
land, more or less together with all & singular the rights, members,
hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining. To Have & To Hold, all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said W. H. Ashmore, his heirs
and assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and
administrators to warrant & defend all and singular the said twenty
acres of land more or less with the premises unto the said W. H. Ashmore
his heirs & assigns and all and every other person or persons. In witness whereof I
