to me in hand paid by William P. Laughlin of the same State & District  
I have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
sell and release unto the said William P. Laughlin the following tract  
or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the State & District aforesaid  
Beginning on an agreed line on Charles Livingston's line at the upper part  
of my plantation on the west side of Peter's Creek and to run on the out-  
side of the fence to the lower part of my plantation, and thence with the  
direction of the fence to the Creek, thence down the Creek to Kings line  
thence in a westerly direction to William Sheffards land, and thence on  
the lines laid down in Richard's deed to me to the beginning, Being  
part of two tracts of land originally granted to Sarah Robinson & Joshua  
Saunders and also being part of the tract deed to me by Bartwell  
Richards the 25<sup>th</sup> Decr 1833, Containing one hundred & sixty acres more  
or less, Together with all and singular the rights, hereditaments or  
appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident, To have and To  
hold, all the above described premises unto the said William P. Laughlin  
his heirs, Exors, Admins & assigns, And I do hereby warrant & save defect
