 Howard all that parcel of land sold by the Sheriff of
 Greenville District as the property of Joseph Howard to O. F.
 Perry, and said Perry to me, situate in said District, on
 branch of Harbans Creek, bounded by Saml Howard et
 al. together with all and singular, the rights members,
 improvements and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
 ing or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and
 to hold, all and singular the said premises unto the said
 John M. Howard his heirs and assigns forever. And I do
 hereby bind myself my heirs executors & assigns to warrant
 and defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 said John M. Howard his heirs and assigns, against my-
 self and my heirs only. Witness my hand & seal this 30th
 day of December 1842. Signed, sealed and delivered in
 the presence of H. Easter
